## Bring Your own Work Gloves and Boots

We have a limited supply of gloves to give away.

On the day of the cleanup pick up supplies such as trash bags, work gloves, plastic buckets, and water at one of the four staging areas.

## Safety First

Report minor injuries to your volunteer leader and zone captain and fill out an accident report (zone captains will have accident reports).

**In the case of a serious accident call 911.**

## Sharp Items- glass, nails, etc.

**BE CAREFUL** when handling anything sharp. Sharp items can rip through trash bags and cause injuries. Place sharps into 5-gallon plastic buckets. The plastic buckets can then be disposed of into dumpsters.

**Hazardous Waste:** Do not touch anything which looks dangerous such as needles, liquids, or sharp objects.

- Call for help
- Report the problem and suspicious material to your volunteer leader
- The volunteer leader will call the zone captain who will report the situation to the Health Department
- The Health Department will remove the Hazardous Waste

**No Yard Waste:** This cleanup is only for removing waste from the environment. The cleanup cannot accommodate yard waste such as bags of leaves, tree branches, and yard trimmings

**Waste Pick Up:** Pile bagged waste collected from your cleanup site neatly on street corners or designated spots. Separate tires, mattresses and electronics for pick up. Call in the location to your zone captain for pick-up.
